Learning Focus: History. Time Travellers: Journey of Transport.

Key knowledge to learn

- Early humans didn't have transport, so used their legs! For a faster mode of travel, they used **animals** to carry them and/or their cargo.
- The **wheel** was invented 5000 years ago, which revolutionised transport, initially enabling a horse and cart to carry heavier loads over longer distances.
- Boats were developed on water in ancient Egypt for fishing, before sailing ships were developed to carry large cargo. Steam engines made boats travel even faster.
- Roads were invented, allowing humans and horses to travel more easily, before the first commercial motor car was invented in the 1900s.
- Rail travel was invented and steam engines allowed faster and cheaper travel.
- Air travel began with the first hot air balloon, before the Wright Brothers invented the first motorised aeroplane in 1903 and space travel became reality in the 1960s.
