## Learning Focus: The History of Music

### Key knowledge to learn

- 1 That music first became printed in the Renaissance period and that vocal and instrumental music was written and performed between the 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> Century
- 2 Baroque music comes from the period between approximately 1600 and 1750. Famous composers from this period include: Antonio Vivaldi, George Frederic Handel and Johann Sebastian Bach
- 3 The classical music era is usually seen as the years between approximately 1750 and 1820. Famous composers from the classical period include: Joseph Haydn and Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart.
- 4 In the Middle Ages the Roman Catholic Church was key to the development of western music. **Plainsong** formed part of worship and musical **notation** developed.
- 5 Romantic period was approximately from 1780 to 1910. Famous composers include Peter Tchaikovsky. Romantic music focuses on provoking emotion and passion.
- 6 The Beatles: John, Paul, George and Ringo were influenced by many types of music: rock and roll, blues, folk and country.

### Vocabulary

<b>Graphic score</b>	A representation of music through the use of visual symbols different to traditional music notation
<b>Composer</b>	A person who writes <b>music</b> in any form, including <b>vocal music</b> , <b>instrumental music</b> and <b>electronic music</b> .
<b>Notation</b>	A system used to visually represent aurally perceived music played with instruments or sung by the human voice
<b>Improvisation</b>	The creative activity of immediate ("in the moment") musical composition
<b>Orchestra</b>	A group of musicians who usually play classical music together and are led by a conductor
<b>Contemporary</b>	A period belonging to the period that started in the mid-1970s to the present day

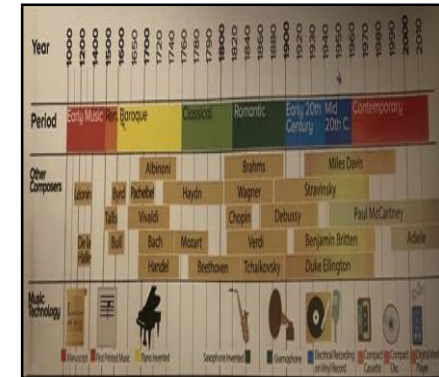
