


## What is phonics?


# Terminology

# Phoneme

#### The smallest unit of sound in a word e.g. Cat has 3 phonemes C-a-t and so does sheep, sh-ee-p

Grapheme

The letter or multiple letters that represent a sound when written on a page



Trigraph

Three letters that represent one sound e.g. igh in light


CVC

#### C = Consonant V = Vowel

Cat – CVC, consonant, vowel, consonant Must-CVCC consonant, vowel, consonant, consonant

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
#### Blending is a merging of the phonemes (sounds) that you hear to make a word. Blending is READING



#### Segmenting

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#### Segmenting is splitting a word up into the phonemes that make it. Then writing the word by representing each phoneme with a grapheme. Segmenting is SPELLING





























## High Frequency Words
